



Whales and Golf in the Midnight Sun Norway

Head for the Arctic Circle and combine a night-time game of golf in the northern midnight sun with a spectacular whale safari through icy fjords. Featuring wildlife, beautiful land- and seascapes and sport, this journey will leave you enchanted with the rugged north of Norway.

Situated on the ocean front at the foot of the craggy Lofoten Mountains above the Arctic Circle, the Lofoten Golf Links offers the unique opportunity of 24-hour golf games under a dramatic midnight sun. From mid-May to early August this golfcourse allows you to play true golf marathons on high-quality grounds – an unforgettable experience that is the fulfilment of every golfer's dream.

Located on flat land by the open sea and facing north, the course is demanding and challenging, particularly as the sea is an integral part of eight of the holes. During your games you are likely to see a variety of

birds including eagles and sea birds and you may even spot a whale or two in the ocean! Accommodation at the Lofoten Golf Links is conveniently situated beside the golf course while the atmospheric Café Hull 19 provides the ideal setting for a relaxing drink after a day – or a night – of golf.

A short stay at the Lofoten Golf Links can easily be combined with a whale safari from the nearby city of Tromsø. This cruise takes you through spectacular fjords with magnificent Arctic panoramas, snow-covered mountain peaks and shifting glaciers. The transition from the shallow continental shelf to the

deep ocean provides a rich source of nourishment for sperm, humpback, finback, minke and killer whales, but also dolphins, porpoises and seals. Depending on the weather the itinerary may be adjusted to choose a more sheltered route that passes by islands and steep cliffs where you can observe hundreds of puffins. The scenic north of Norway is also ideally suited for hiking, with a wide range of trails and paths leading through spectacular rugged mountain landscapes.
